Anthony E. "Tony" Robinette, 56, of Ashland, Kentucky, passed away Sunday, May 23, 2021. Tony was born December 30, 1964 to Janet Nicola Justice Robinette and the late Jack E. Robinette of Ashland. Tony was a faithful member of Hyland Heights Baptist church in Catlettsburg. He was a devoted Christian who loved fellowship and serving in all capacities for God. He graduated on May 27 of 1987 as a proud member of the United States Military Academy class of 1987 and company E, 2nd Regiment (Go Dogs).
