Claude E. Erwin 96, of Ashland, KY died Monday April 18, 2016 at his residence. He was born November 4, 1919 in Raceland, KY the son of the late Mr. and Mrs. Lon Erwin. He was retired from CSX Railroad, a member of the American Legion Post 76 and a U.S. Army WWII veteran, serving as a lead scout until being wounded in battle for the second time in 1944 and finishing out his military career with the military police until his discharge in 1945. In addition to his parents he was also preceded in death by his wife Mary Elizabeth Erwin and a grandson Timothy Erwin Jr. Survivors include two sons, Christopher Erwin and wife Linda and Timothy M. Erwin Sr. and wife Connie of Ashland, KY, one daughter, Marcia Gail Boles of Ironton, OH, 6 grandchildren, 12 great grandchildren and 1 great great grandchild.
