Daniel Patton Cooksey, 74, of Flatwoods, Kentucky passed away December 17, of a brief illness. Daniel was born July 22, 1947 in Ashland to the late Fred Miller Cooksey and Ellen Hearne Cooksey. In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his brother, Joe Bill Cooksey and a niece Joyce Chadwell.
