Always willing, and honored, to provide food for any event, some of her most requested foods were her famous cucumber sandwiches, Snickerdoodles and her Mt. Dew cakes. Glenna was an energetic, dynamic and truly special person for all of her 96 years on this earth and was inspiring to all who knew her. Though Heaven is rejoicing, she will be sadly missed by her family and friends and will forever be remembered as "Nana" to her beloved grandchildren and great-grandchildren.
