



## Grover C Hatfield

February 6, 1935 - August 9, 2025

Grover Cleveland “GC” Hatfield, 90, of Raceland, KY, went home to be with the Lord on Saturday, August 9, 2025, while under the compassionate care of Hospice at the Lantern at Morning Pointe in Russell.

Born on February 6, 1935, in Belfry, KY, Grover was the son of the late Basil and Elizabeth Smith Hatfield. A proud 1954 graduate of Belfry High School, he went on to serve his country with honor as a member of the U.S. Army’s 82nd Airborne Division.

Grover was a devoted member of Wurtland Missionary Baptist Church, where he faithfully served as a deacon, trustee, and longtime choir member. His love for the Lord was evident in the life he lived and the service he gave to others. A man of many talents, Grover was a former barber and retired as a security guard from Armco/AK Steel through Johnson Controls. He also co-owned the Country Bow-Kay Flower Shop, where he became well known for delivering flowers — often with a song and a smile.

An avid outdoorsman, Grover enjoyed hunting, fishing, and bike riding. However, his greatest joy came from cheering on his grandchildren in their sports and supporting his beloved Raceland Rams, a passion he proudly carried for over 50 years.

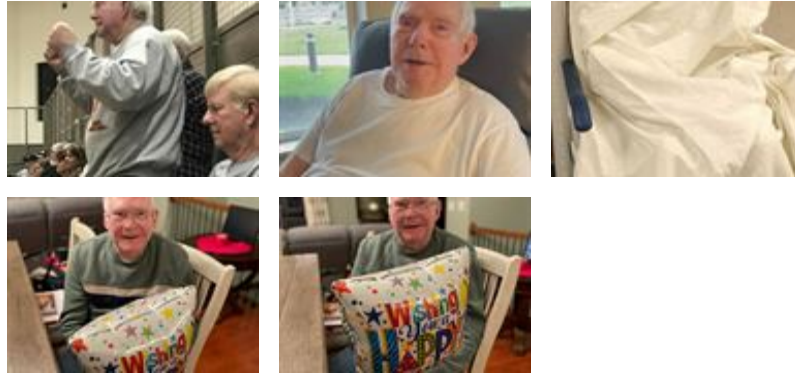

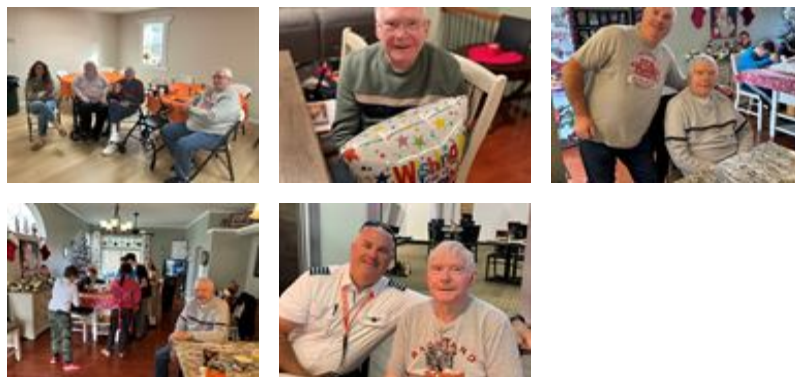
