

Terrence E. "Terry" Rehmel

Terrence Eugene "Terry" Rehmel, 81, of Rush, Kentucky, passed away peacefully Tuesday morning, September 23, 2025 surrounded by his loving wife and daughters by his side.

Born on July 29, 1944, in South Bend, Indiana, Terry was the son of the late Fred Rehmel and LaDonna Powell Rehmel. In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his beloved grandson Todd, a great granddaughter Skyler and a son-in-law Paul Schmidt.

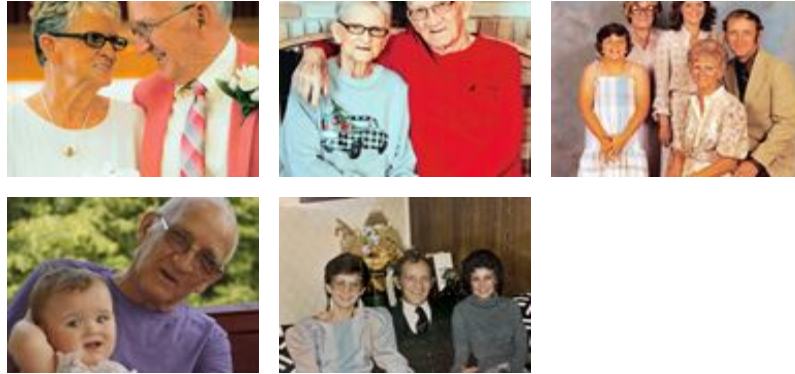
